Summary:

As believers seeking a deeper understanding of who Jesus really is, we must go deeper than religious definitions. Jesus Christ wasn't simply a man sent by God, but He is the creator Himself in human form. Jesus' mission was to deliver eternal grace and truth to mankind, and He was the only one able to do so. Jesus the Son was, and is, on the same level as God the Father; He's preeminent. He can't be compared to Moses, who gave the law, because He's far greater. Jesus is the Word, but the Word is more than just a revelation of God that we read; He's God. There's no one higher; having a personal relationship with Him gives us an eternal perspective.

Notes:

1. God—and Jesus—have always been. They were in existence even before time began. Jesus was not the created, but the creator in human form.
2. In his first letter to the Colossians, Paul affirmed Jesus as the deity, the one true God in human form. Christ is the Word in the flesh.
3. Jesus Christ came to earth to bring grace and truth to mankind. Jesus isn't just *from* God, He *is* God. He's infinite.
4. We can't know God without a relationship with Jesus; they're one and the same. The Book of John was written so that we might know God through Jesus Christ, the anointed one. Believing in Him gives us eternal life.
