Summary:

Christmas is a major global event, but most people are unaware of the real reasons why Jesus was born. Millions of people who observe Christmas don't even believe in Him; the significance of His birth goes much deeper than the secular holiday traditions the world has created. A single event—the birth of Jesus—changed the entire course of human history. This is something we can wholeheartedly celebrate.

Notes:

- 1. Jesus came to save us, show us grace and truth, and make us part of the family of God.
- 2. The first five reasons He was born were to save us from our sins, to redeem us from living under the Law of Moses (so that we could be adopted as God's children), to fulfill the law which we could not fulfill, to be a mediator of a better covenant, and to bring us grace and truth.
- 3. Christ was the perfect sacrifice for our sins; He opened heaven to us and offered us eternal salvation.
- 4. The other five reasons He was born were to pay the price for our sins, give us everlasting life, to end condemnation and replace it with salvation, to make the Holy Spirit available to *all* of us, and to provide the promised seed of Abraham.
