Summary:

The Holy Spirit is the key to us receiving under the new covenant of grace. He's the one who administers it, and a relationship with Him is therefore necessary. The law unsuccessfully tried to change man from the outside in; by contrast, grace transforms us from the inside out. Under grace, our hearts—not our actions motivated by a sense of obligation—are what's most important to God. The Holy Spirit does things that we're incapable of doing, and gives us insight and wisdom that we don't have. We receive what He wants to give us by seeking His guidance and prompting, and by listening for His clear, distinct voice. Practicing these things helps us hear Him clearly.

Notes:

1. Grace can change what we can't change in ourselves. The Holy Spirit, not us, does the work.
2. We're not righteous because of anything we did, but because of what Jesus did. Grace is based on His finished works.
3. It's impossible to live under grace without the Holy Spirit, who teaches us to live a life of faith; by comparison, no faith is required to live under the law, because the law is completely performance-based.
4. The Holy Spirit works with us by teaching and revealing truth, guiding us in our decisions, empowering us to live righteously, and confirming our identity. He also prays for us and through us, produces the fruit of the Spirit in us, and gives us boldness and power.
5. We work with the Holy Spirit by acknowledging Him, listening and responding, staying in the Word, praying with Him, and resting in grace.
