Summary:

Knowing our identity in Christ elevates our lives to a whole new level. Jesus' death and resurrection defeated sin, brought reconciliation to all of humanity, and defined who we are in Him. Under grace, sin isn't what we do, but being out of sync with our true identity as God's sons and daughters. Knowing who we are allows us to walk in authority; it means living in agreement with God concerning who He says we are. We've been made holy and righteous without us having to earn this status by our performance. We no longer have to rely on useless self-effort, because victory in life is one of the finished works of Jesus. Being aware of what has already been done for us protects us from the enemy's lies and attacks.

Notes:

1. We must define who we are through the lens of Jesus Christ, not through the lens of the world.
2. Jesus is the great "I am" in us; He mirrors our wholeness and endorses our true identity.
3. To be in sync with our Jesus identity means we stop striving to become and start believing that we already are.
4. The benefits of being in sync with our Jesus identity include rest, peace, boldness, freedom, and godly love.
5. Jesus knew exactly who He was. As children of God, we need the same level of confidence.
6. Jesus was always keenly aware of His union with the Father, who was always delighted with His Son. During His ministry, Jesus operated out of His true identity.
