Summary:

It's impossible to separate the Holy Spirit from the Gospel of Grace. Unlike the long lists of rules and regulations that administered the law, the Spirit now administers this new covenant and governs the believer in love. The focus has shifted from Old-Testament rules to New-Testament faith; God's commandments are no longer carved in stone, but now written in our hearts. The law was unable to transform people; only grace can do that. Listening to the Holy Spirit with our hearts gives us peace, and gives us insight and wisdom to make the right decisions in life. Letting Him guide and direct us is a sign of spiritual maturity. Yielding to the Holy Ghost, our unseen partner, allows us to prosper and live abundantly.

Notes:

1. Grace succeeds where the law failed. The Spirit leads us out from under the law and changes us.
2. The law was unable to administer morality through rule-keeping; it failed miserably. This was why God replaced it with grace.
3. The old covenant relied on external laws, but the new covenant is all about the Spirit giving us life from within.
4. Real and lasting change doesn't come from anything we do in our own efforts, but only through God working in us.
5. The Holy Spirit lives in us; we must therefore take our directions from Him. We're to listen to Him with our hearts.
6. Our salvation isn't because of anything good we did, but because God had mercy on us.
