Summary:

To benefit from God's grace, we must first understand it. As the human manifestation of grace, Jesus made it possible for us to live free from sin and condemnation. Depending on Him allows Him to be our provision, both on the physical and on the spiritual level. He's our provider, our righteousness, and everything else we need in this life. What Jesus did for us on the cross He did out of love, not because we deserved anything good from Him. His death was necessary in order to satisfy God's law of justice, which called for death as the penalty for sin; it enabled God to show mankind His infinite, unrestricted love. Because of the ultimate sacrifice Jesus made, God can now deal with us with mercy and kindness under grace instead of through judgment and punishment under the law.

Notes:

1. Grace teaches us compassion, mercy, and godliness; it's *not* an excuse to continue sinning.
2. Jesus is grace, and grace is the operation of God's love; Jesus' willingness to die for us was born out of His love.
3. We can't earn God's grace; it's a gift we receive when we believe in Jesus. Grace is undeserved. God's love is infinite. *He's* infinite; therefore, so are His attributes.
4. Grace enables us to do God's will. He extended grace to us so that we can extend it to others. God's grace always acts on our behalf, first, to enable us to act on His behalf afterward.
5. Believers will still sin, but God doesn't count it against them. What separated us from God before we got born again was our sinful nature.
