Summary:

True prosperity begins with understanding our identity as the beloved of God. It's not defined by money but by wholeness—nothing missing, nothing broken. Prosperity flows from the inside out, beginning with a prosperous soul. God desires holistic prosperity that includes health, peace, purpose, and provision. The spirit of Mammon seeks to replace God by promising what only He can give. Abiding in Christ, not striving, is the key to fruitfulness and success. Grace transforms our soul by removing sin-consciousness and anchoring us in our identity in Christ.

Notes:

1. Prosperity begins with knowing God loves and accepts you. He affirms our identity as the beloved, not based on performance.
2. Prosperity includes finances, health, peace, purpose, identity, and relationships. Removing one area affects the whole; true prosperity is comprehensive.
3. Health Is part of the inheritance. It isn't a reward for good behavior but a fruit of the finished work of Jesus.
4. Fruitfulness comes from abiding in Christ. Like Joseph in Genesis chapter 39, success comes from God's presence, not from possessions.
5. Mammon promises what only God can give—security, identity, and peace. Giving breaks Mammon's control and affirms God as our source.
