Summary:

True prosperity is wholeness, meaning nothing missing and nothing broken, and it's not limited to just financial wealth. Wholeness includes peace, health, relationships, purpose, joy, security, and a clear identity in Christ. This prosperity is a finished work through Jesus and is received, not earned, by performance or religious duty. Believers are called to rest in the reality that they're already blessed and to live from that truth. The overall goal is to shift from striving and fear of lack to resting and trusting in God's unending provision.

Notes:

1. Prosperity isn't just money; it's wholeness in every area (peace, health, purpose, relationships, security, joy, and identity).
2. Like righteousness, redemption, and sanctification, prosperity is already completed in Christ. We don't strive for it; we rest in it.
3. Giving isn't performance to earn blessing but an act of trust aligning with what is already done.
4. Four devotions to continue walking in wholeness include believing and resting in your true identity; renewing your mind to grace; generosity from a place of trust; and seeking intimacy with God over formulas.
5. Grace-based prosperity isn't about sowing to get, tithing to be blessed, or performing religious duties for favor. It *is* about believing and receiving what Christ already provided.
